I might be given a new timetable to follow.


I don't need to worry about this. I will ask a teacher for help if I have any questions about my timetable.

I don't need to worry about getting lost.


I can show a teacher my timetable. They will tell me how to get to the room.

How will I know who will teach me?


I will have different teachers for my lessons.

Each teacher has a code. This is on my timetable.




Sometimes I might not have the teacher I expect so in the lesson. This could happen if my teacher is away from school.
