### Summer Uniform Changes

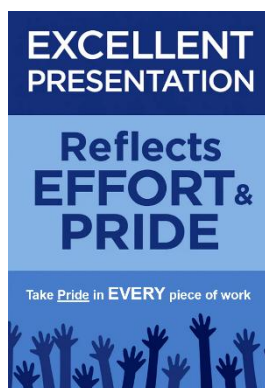

## Holland Trip – exciting opportunity

We are excited to announce a proposed **Sports Tour to Valkenburg, Holland** during May Half Term 2026, for students with a passion for football and adventure! It would mark one of Cliff Park's first overseas trips for some years and is shaping up to be one of its most memorable!

This five-day trip promises to be a memorable experience, combining competitive football fixtures with cultural exploration and personal development. Students will enjoy:

We are excited to introduce a **BRAND-NEW** Student Leadership Team (SSLT) at Cliff Park Ormiston Academy, designed to give students a powerful voice in school life and the opportunity to shadow key areas of school leadership.

This structure has been carefully developed to mirror and shadow the roles within our Senior Leadership Team, giving students genuine insight into how the academy operates, while empowering them to lead on initiatives that matter to their peers.

At the centre of the structure is the Student Principal, who will work alongside staff and students to influence decision-making, lead meetings, and support whole-school development.

Applications for this prestigious role opened on Monday 9th June 2025 and must be submitted via a formal application form with the requirement for a reference from staff. Appointments will be made

through a shortlisting and interview panel process, ensuring the role is awarded fairly and transparently. It is open to all year groups, 7 through to 10.

The successful Student Principal will then play a key role in selecting the wider leadership team, including deputies responsible for curriculum, wellbeing, behaviour, enrichment and more.
