Student Behaviour on Public Transport – Representing our Academy with Pride

At Cliff Park Ormiston Academy, we are proud of the way our students conduct themselves in school, and we expect the same high standards to be upheld in the wider community — including on public transport.

Many of our students use local bus services each day, and we've been pleased to receive positive comments from members of the public about the respectful and courteous behaviour of most students. However, we've also been made aware of a few incidents where behaviour has fallen short of the standards we expect.

We want to remind all students that when wearing the Cliff Park uniform, you are representing not just yourself, but our whole school community. Whether you're on the way to school or returning home, your behaviour makes a lasting impression.

Here's how you can help:

- Use respectful language and speak at a reasonable volume.
- Offer your seat to those who may need it, including the elderly, disabled passengers, or those with young children.
- Dispose of litter properly and respect the bus environment.
- Follow the driver's instructions and travel safely at all times.
- Treat other passengers and transport staff with kindness and courtesy.

We will continue to work with local transport providers to monitor behaviour and ensure that all students feel safe and supported on their journeys. Inappropriate behaviour may be reported back to the school and could result in follow-up action.

Respecting our Staff – A Polite Reminder

At Cliff Park Ormiston Academy, we are proud of the strong and positive relationships we have with the vast majority of our parents and carers. Our staff work incredibly hard every day to support your children and are committed to doing the very best for every student.
