Introduction of Tootoot Safeguarding System

As part of our ongoing commitment to promoting a safe, supportive and inclusive environment at Cliff Park Ormiston Academy, I am pleased to inform you that we have introduced a new platform called Tootoot as an additional element of our anti-bullying and safeguarding strategy.

Tootoot is a safe, anonymous online service that allows students to report concerns or worries they may have – whether they are experiencing bullying, struggling with wellbeing, or have seen or heard something they feel uncomfortable about. It empowers young people to speak up and seek help in a way that feels secure.

We officially launched Tootoot to students on Friday 17th March, and it is now fully accessible for all students. Every student has received information on how to log in and use the platform, and our staff have been fully briefed on how to respond and provide the appropriate support.

We believe that every student has the right to feel safe and respected, and Tootoot enhances our ability to listen, respond and act swiftly when concerns are raised. While this is not a replacement for face-to-face communication, it is a valuable additional option for students who may find it difficult to speak out in person.
