
Congratulations to Corben Year 9 who recently competed in the England Indoor athletics championships in Sheffield. Qualifying times are required just to enter this competition. Corben qualified to semi-finals in 60m and got a new personal best time of 7.52 seconds. He then qualified for the final in 200m gaining a personal best of 23.72 seconds, which is also a Norfolk county record for U15 boys indoor 200m. Finishing 5th in the U15 boys 200m.
