Students who are unable to find a placement will be required to attend the academy as normal and will be accessing a number of workshops.


## **Building for the Future: Academy Facilities Update**



We're pleased to share an update on the recent and upcoming building works taking place at the academy. These improvements reflect our ongoing commitment to creating a safe, modern, and inspiring learning environment for all students and staff.

#### **Recently Completed Works**

Over the past year, the academy has made significant strides in upgrading key facilities:





#### **Science Lab Refurbishment**

Our science lab has undergone a full transformation. It now features new workbenches, enhanced utilities, modern storage solutions, and cutting-edge teaching equipment, supporting engaging, hands-on learning.



## **Student Toilet Refurbishment**

Toilets across the site have been fully modernised, with new fixtures, ventilation systems, and high-quality finishes, improving hygiene, accessibility, and overall comfort.

### Mechanical and Electrical (M&E) System Upgrades

Essential mechanical and electrical systems have been upgraded, including lighting, heating, and electrical infrastructure. These improvements enhance energy efficiency, reduce maintenance issues, and ensure a more comfortable environment for learning.

Looking to the future, several exciting projects are planned as part of our ongoing development strategy:

### Coming in 2025:

- Technology Classroom Refurbishment
   Our technology spaces will be reimagined to support modern teaching methods, with new
   furnishings, upgraded tools, and a more functional layout for both practical and digital
   design.
- Further M&E Upgrades
   We will continue upgrading aging mechanical and electrical items to improve performance, reliability, and sustainability.

### Planned for 2026:

- Transformation of Academy Building Exterior
   A significant investment will be made to replace windows and facias, improving both the building's energy efficiency and its visual appeal.
- Brand New Sports Hall Floor
   The sports hall will receive a new floor, ensuring a high-quality surface for PE lessons, sports clubs, and school events.
- Additional M&E Enhancements
   Continued investment into mechanical and electrical systems will further modernise and futureproof the academy's infrastructure.

These projects mark an exciting time of renewal and investment at the academy. We thank our students, staff, and families for their ongoing support and patience as we work to build a better future for our school community.

## Student Leadership Team Launch - Applications Opening!

We are excited to introduce a **BRAND-NEW** Student Leadership Team (SSLT) at Cliff Park Ormiston Academy, designed to give students a powerful voice in school life and the opportunity to shadow key areas of school leadership.

This structure has been carefully developed to mirror and shadow the roles within our Senior Leadership Team, giving students genuine insight into how the academy operates, while empowering them to lead on initiatives that matter to their peers.

At the centre of the structure is the Student Principal, who will work alongside staff and students to influence decision-making, lead meetings, and support whole-school development.

Applications for this prestigious role open on Monday 9th June 2025 and must be submitted via a formal application form with the requirement for a reference from staff. Appointments will be made through a shortlisting and interview panel process, ensuring the role is awarded fairly and transparently. It is open to all year groups, 7 through to 10.

The successful Student Principal will then play a key role in selecting the wider leadership team, including deputies responsible for curriculum, wellbeing, behaviour, enrichment and more.

We look forward to seeing our students step forward to lead with vision, voice and pride.
