# **Staying Safe Around Water:**

As the warmer months approach and more young people spend time outdoors, we want to take a moment to highlight the importance of **water safety**. Whether it's swimming pools, rivers, lakes, canals, or the sea, being near open water can pose serious risks—especially for children and teenagers.

While water can seem inviting and fun, it's essential that young people understand how to stay safe.

# Key Water Safety Tips to Share with Your Child:

- Never swim alone. Always be with a trusted adult or friend in safe, supervised areas.
- Stick to lifeguarded areas whenever possible.
- **Cold water can be dangerous.** Even in summer, open water can cause cold water shock, which can affect breathing and coordination.
- Avoid jumping or diving into water unless you're certain of the depth and what's beneath the surface.
- Stay away from weirs, fast-moving currents, and locks, especially in canals and rivers.
- Don't use inflatables on open water like rivers or the sea—they can easily drift.

## What Parents and Carers Can Do:

- Talk openly with your child about the risks, especially around unsupervised swimming or tombstoning.
- Encourage them to look out for friends and to seek help if someone is in trouble—never go in after someone; call 999 immediately.
- Consider enrolling your child in **swimming and water safety sessions** if they haven't had formal lessons.

We all want our young people to enjoy the outdoors—but safely. Please take a few minutes to talk to your child about water safety this summer. It could save a life.
