# Free School Meals - Don't Miss Out!

At Cliff Park Ormiston Academy, we want every student to have the best start to each school day. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals (FSM), we strongly encourage you to apply — it's quick, confidential, and can make a big difference.

By taking up Free School Meals, students benefit from:

- A nutritious meal each day to help them concentrate and achieve their best in lessons.
- Access to additional support for learning, as the school receives extra funding (Pupil Premium) for every student registered.
- The reassurance that all applications are treated in confidence no one can tell who is receiving Free School Meals.

Even if your child prefers to bring a packed lunch, registering still brings valuable additional funding to the academy.

# **Road Safety Outside the Academy**

As we begin the new term, we want to remind everyone of the importance of road safety around the academy, especially during busy drop-off and pick-up times. The safety of our students remains our highest priority, and with your support we can keep the area outside school safe for all children.

# **Parking Guidance:**

- Please do not park on double yellow lines or zig-zag markings outside the school. These
  are there to keep sight lines clear for drivers and pedestrians and to reduce congestion.
   Parking here makes it harder for children to cross safely and increases risk for everyone.
- Use nearby legal parking spaces or designated drop-off zones.
- Avoid blocking driveways or school entrances.
- Allow a few extra minutes on your journey to find safe parking.
   Even stopping "just for a minute" on restricted lines can put children at risk.

#### For Pedestrians and Students:

- Cross only at safe points and avoid stepping between parked cars.
- Stay alert to traffic and avoid distractions such as phones or headphones.
- During darker mornings, encourage children to wear bright or reflective clothing.

By working together, we can ensure the roads around Cliff Park Ormiston Academy remain safe for everyone. Thank you for your continued cooperation and care. If you have any concerns, please contact the school office.
