The winners were Ms Green's Form who managed to secure 139 dollars in just 3 school days demonstrating amazing resilience!


KEY STAGE 4: YEAR 10

ATTENDANCE MATTERS - CAN YOUR CHILD JOIN THE 1% CLUB?

Improving attendance by just 1% can make a huge difference to your child's learning.

The 1% club is an attendance incentive that isn't about being perfect. It's about getting 1% better. If your child already attends really well, they can qualify by hitting a perfect streak until the end of term.

If your child can improve their attendance by over 1% over the next 20 days, they will gain entry to the 1% club and a chance to win £150
